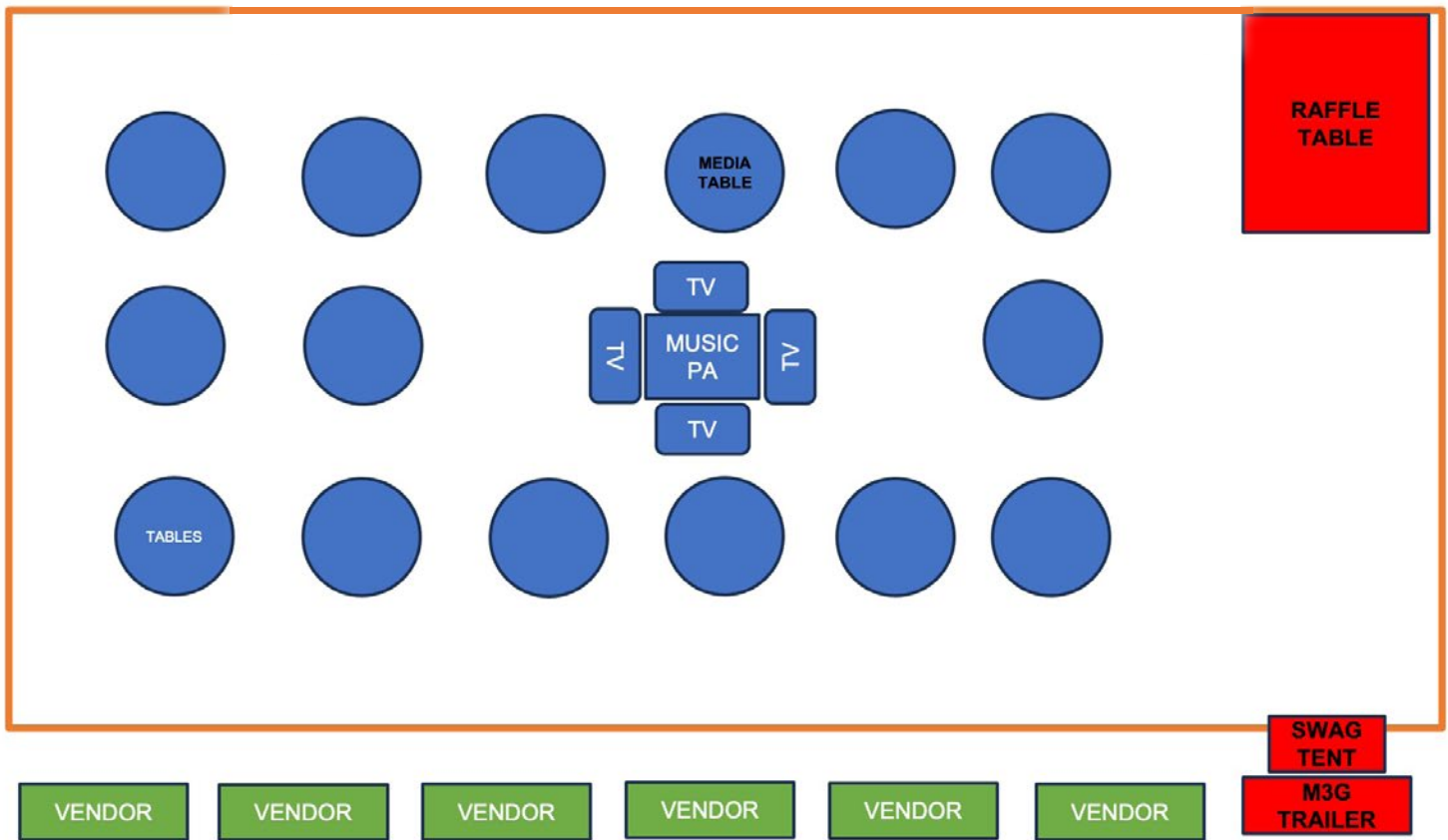

At the beginning of each stage, there is a banner memorializing the honoree. We encourage everyone to write/sign the banners to let our Fallen Brothers and their Gold Star Families know that their names live on in our hearts and minds.

STAGE 1 - SSG KEITH BISHOP



SSG Keith R. Bishop, 28, died heroically on October 26, 2009, in a helicopter crash during a combat mission in Darreh-Ye Bum, Afghanistan, while serving with Bravo Company, 3rd Battalion, 7th Special Forces Group (Airborne).

On his second deployment for Operation Enduring Freedom, Keith exemplified unwavering commitment to his country. Enlisting in the Army in 2003 as an Infantryman, he served with distinction in Korea and the 2nd Infantry Division.

In 2008, his perseverance earned him the Green Beret as a Special Forces weapons sergeant. Born in Medford, N.Y., Keith's infectious humor and quick wit brought joy to everyone around him. He cherished his wife, Margaret, his parents, Robert and Suzan, and siblings, Steve, Janeane, Janice, and twin sister Kim. Keith found balance through his passions for fishing, snowboarding, and fitness, reflecting his disciplined yet vibrant spirit.

His courage, loyalty, and kindness left a lasting impact on his family, friends, and fellow soldiers. Keith's legacy as a true hero endures in the hearts of those who knew him. His sacrifice for freedom will never be forgotten.

STAGE 2 - SP4 KEITH CAMPBELL



SP4 Keith Allen Campbell, driven by a childhood dream to serve as an Army doctor, enlisted in the U.S. Army at 17 after earning his GED. An avid outdoorsman, he excelled in swimming, archery, horseback riding, and skydiving. Serving nearly three years, he attained the rank of Specialist 5 and joined the 11th Special Forces Group. During his first combat deployment in the Dominican Republic, he earned a Bronze Star recommendation. After an Honorable Discharge, he re-enlisted as a combat medic with the 503rd Parachute Regiment, 173rd Airborne Brigade, accepting a rank reduction to serve in Vietnam. On February 8, 1967, at age 20, Campbell heroically sacrificed his life in Bien Hoa Province, Vietnam, shielding a patient and saving many soldiers. His selfless actions as a medic exemplified his dedication to a greater cause. In 2006, soldiers he saved gathered to honor him at the rededication of the Joint Base San Antonio / Ft. Sam Houston Library to the Keith A. Campbell Memorial Library.

He is buried in Arlington National Cemetery beside childhood friends. Campbell's legacy endures on the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall, the Virginia War Memorial, and other memorials.

STAGE 3 - CPT CONNOR BEDNARZYK



CPT Connor Bednarzyk was a dedicated U.S. Army Ranger with the 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment at Fort Benning, Georgia. He tragically died on September 7, 2018, in a single tactical vehicle accident. During his three-year Army career, Connor displayed exceptional leadership, skill, and commitment to his country.

A 2015 Penn State graduate, he earned a Security Risk Analysis degree, graduating in the top 10% of ROTC cadets nationwide. A high school three-sport athlete and college boxer, his competitive spirit shone in his military service. Known for inspiring others, he was always first to volunteer for tough tasks. Connor had a gift for uniting people and cherished time with friends and family.

His warmth, humility, and love for life, including playing piano and guitar, left a lasting impact. Though his life was cut short, his legacy as a leader, warrior, and friend endures. His memory continues to inspire all who knew him.

STAGE 4 - MATTHEW “KYLE” EVANS



Matthew “Kyle” Evans was a highly decorated Green Beret and served nearly half his life in the U.S. Army. He was driven by a fierce patriotism that defined his career. His vibrant personality, filled with humor, captivating stories, and lively dance moves, commanded every room.

Fierce, fearless, and authentic, he was deeply dedicated to his country, friends, and family. As a devoted husband and father, he cherished his 4-year-old daughter, his greatest pride, and eagerly awaited his unborn son.

Tragically, on May 25, 2019, Kyle’s life was cut short, leaving a profound void in the hearts of all who knew him. His love for his children and country inspired the creation of a foundation in his memory. The Let It Shine Foundation supports children who, like his own, lost a parent serving the nation. Kyle’s adventurous spirit and boundless love continue to shine through his family and friends.

His legacy endures through the foundation, bringing hope and joy to children facing loss. Kyle remains a true American hero whose light will never fade.

STAGE NOTES:

STAGE 5 - SGT PATRICK HAWKINS



SGT Patrick Hawkins, 25, from Carlisle, PA, was killed in action on October 6, 2013, by an improvised explosive device in Kandahar Province, Afghanistan, during his fourth deployment.

Enlisting in the U.S. Army in February 2010, he completed infantry training at Fort Benning, Georgia. After graduating from the Basic Airborne Course, he joined the Ranger Assessment and Selection Program. Assigned to Bravo Company, 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment in September 2010, he served as a Rifleman, Gun Team Leader, and Ranger Team Leader.

As a Ranger, Hawkins selflessly dedicated his life to others, becoming a vital part of the Army's premier direct-action raid force. He fought courageously in support of the War on Terror, serving his fellow Rangers and the nation. Posthumously, he was awarded the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, and Purple Heart.

His commitment and sacrifice left a lasting impact on those who served alongside him. Hawkins is survived by his wife and parents. His legacy as a valiant soldier and devoted family man endures.

STAGE NOTES:

STAGE 6 - CPT TREVOR GRAVES



CPT Trevor Graves, born in Anchorage, Alaska, cherished his home state's mountains and wilderness, growing up alongside his brother Michael. An avid long-distance runner, fisherman, and hunter, he was both an artist and a warrior who lived for community, friendship, and love. Enlisting in the Army in 2001, he served with the 5th Special Forces Group during Operation IRAQI FREEDOM and later commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant after attending West Point. Trevor deployed twice with the 10th Mountain Division for Operation ENDURING FREEDOM and, after earning his Green Beret, returned to the 5th SFG. In 2017, he co-founded the Legion 9/11 Memorial Run & Gun, uniting Green Berets, Gold Star families, veterans, and civilians to honor the fallen. The event, launched in just four months, became a cathartic tribute to the 5th Group's story and its community. As Executive Officer of C Company, 4th Battalion, 5th SFG until 2022, he exemplified selfless leadership.

Reassigned to Anchorage's 11th Airborne Division to care for his terminally ill father, Trevor remained devoted to his family. Tragically, in March 2023, just before his retirement after 22 years of service, he took his own life. He is survived by his wife Clo, daughter Jeanne, brother Michael, and mother Merriel.

STAGE NOTES:

STAGE 7 - SGT TYLER SHELTON



SGT Tyler Shelton, born September 26, 1998, in San Bernardino, California, was killed on August 27, 2020, during aviation training on San Clemente Island, California, at age 21. Serving with Charlie Company, 1st Battalion, 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (Airborne), he was a dedicated soldier.

Enlisting in the U.S. Army in 2016, he trained as a 15T UH-60 Black Hawk Repairer at Fort Campbell, Kentucky. After completing Enlisted Combat Skills (Green Platoon) training, he joined Foxtrot Company, 1st Battalion, as an MH-60M Repairer for eight months. In 2018, he was selected for Charlie Company as an MH-60M DAP Crew Chief.

Shelton deployed to Afghanistan for Operation FREEDOM'S SENTINEL, logging over 500 flight hours, including 200 under night-vision goggles. His service exemplified commitment to the 160th SOAR's elite aviation mission.

Posthumously, he received the Meritorious Service Medal and Army Commendation Medal with Combat device.

STAGE 8 - MSG TONY YOST



MSG Anthony Ray Charles Yost, born October 9, 1966, in Flint, Michigan, enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1987, serving in Fort Lewis, Fort Bliss, and South Korea before becoming a Special Forces soldier. Graduating from the Special Forces Qualification Course in 1993, he joined the 2nd Battalion, 10th Special Forces Group as a Weapons Sergeant. From 2001, he served as a senior Special Forces Weapons Instructor at Fort Bragg's John F. Kennedy Special Warfare School, later joining the 3rd Battalion, 3rd Special Forces Group in 2005. Yost, a proud Apache Indian, fulfilled his dream of becoming a sniper, earning jump wings and High Altitude Low Opening (HALO) qualifications. Passionate about gunsmithing, he completed a course at Montgomery Community College, aspiring to open Apache Gunworks post-retirement. An avid Harley rider, he enjoyed poker runs, Crown Royal, and Coronas, embodying a hardworking yet charming persona. Leading Operational Detachment Alpha 381, he died heroically in Mosul, Iraq, on November 19, 2005, after 18.5 years of service.

The MSG Anthony R.C. Yost Weapons Training Facility, named in his honor in 2015, reflects his love for training and weaponry. His mentorship of "SF Babies" and leadership as a Team Sergeant defined his legacy.

STAGE 9 - SFC PEDRO MUNOZ



SFC Pedro A. Munoz, born June 30, 1957, in Quebradillas, Puerto Rico, served as a detachment operations and intelligence sergeant with the 1st Battalion, 7th Special Forces Group (Airborne) at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He died on January 2, 2005, from wounds sustained by enemy small arms fire during offensive operations in Shindand, Afghanistan.

Enlisting in the Army in February 1986 as an automated logistical specialist, he graduated from the Special Forces Qualification Course in 1990. Munoz deployed with the 3rd Special Forces Group for Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm, and in 1994, he served seven months in Haiti for Operation Uphold Democracy.

In 1999, he joined the U.S. Army Parachute Team, the Golden Knights, completing over 300 static line and 4,000 free fall jumps.

He returned to the Special Forces in 2002 with the 7th SFG. Munoz was posthumously awarded the Silver Star for his gallantry in Afghanistan. His courage and dedication defined his 19-year career.

MSG Cristobal L. Vallejo (Ret), born April 28, 1982, was a Green Beret known for his boundless energy, quiet strength, and immense heart. Enlisting in the U.S. Army after high school, he served with honor in the 2nd BN, 6th Infantry, 1st Armored Division, 10th Special Forces Group, and USASOC at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. After losing teammate Ryan Savard, Cris co-founded the Coast X Coast Foundation to support veterans and families healing from war's silent injuries. The foundation, rooted in brotherhood, helped countless veterans find purpose and connection. An avid outdoorsman and natural athlete, Cris excelled in sports and lived with a zest for adventure. As a devoted husband to Marcy and father to Van, he filled their lives with love, laughter, and unforgettable dad jokes. His optimism and generosity touched everyone, from his mother, Kate, to his wide circle of friends. Tragically, on July 2, 2023, at the age of 41, Cris suffered a brain hemorrhage due to a wartime TBI and died in a car accident along with his dog, Dale.

His legacy endures through the Coast X Coast Foundation and the love he shared with his family and community.
